The VRIC Medical Clinic is planning to reopen in a phased manner from October 24th, 2020. Appointments will be once a week, mostly on Saturdays from 9 am to 12:30 pm.

Please refer to the following guidelines carefully for making an appointment:

- Only those patients who do not have **any** medical coverage (this includes Medicaid or Parkland insurance) are eligible to be seen in the clinic.
- For now, **only** patients who are already established at the VRIC Medical Clinic will be seen. Insha'Allah, we will open up for new patients in the near future.
- There is no emergency treatment available at the clinic. For Urgent/Emergent issues, please call 911 or go the nearest Emergency Room.
- Please call the Clinic Phone number at (972) 827-7041 and leave a voicemail with the following information
 - Full Name
 - Call Back Number
- Scheduler will reach back out to patient to confirm their appointment, and the time slot they will be given.
- Patients should stay in their vehicles in the masjid parking lot. They will be called on their phones when it is time for their appointment and the clinic is ready for them.
- There will be a screening booth set up outside the VRIC entrance, including temperature checks. Only those that pass the screening questions will be allowed in.
- Patients will be seen by appointment only. NO walk ins.
- Only one person (the patient) will be allowed inside the Masjid, unless it's a pediatric patient (in which case only one parent/guardian should accompany the child).
- Patients must keep a face mask on at all times, covering both the nose and mouth.
- In-person clinic visits are **only** for follow up of chronic medical issues and or Med/refills.
- Patients who have been in contact with known Covid-19 positive cases, or with **any** of the following should report their symptoms when making the appointment:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea

The clinic will do a virtual doctor visit for these patients. (**PLEASE DO NOT** come to the masjid). Please ensure that you give a working phone number for the physician to call you.

Since all patients are required to be registered before being seen, (and we can presently only do on-site registration), all virtual visits are for patients that have already been seen in the clinic previously and NOT for any new patients.

- Patient understands that there are no future or follow-up medical treatment, or medical advice, or refills guaranteed. No after-hours medical assistance or advice may be available.
- We do not offer chronic pain management.
- Abide by social distancing measure at all times keeping a 6 ft distance
- Masjid bathrooms are closed.
- Drinking fountains are not accessible.
- Please follow all VRIC masjid protocols.
